FAST, HEALTHY COOKING THE FOCUS OF FREE CLASS AT WESTERN SIERRA MEDICAL CLINIC

Local nutritionist and obesity prevention expert leads one-hour class on May 20 as part of Weight Loss Support Group Program

GRASS VALLEY – Quick and easy meals can also be healthy and nutritious – and are critical to a successful weight-loss program.

A free class will share cooking tips to create simple and tasty dishes 4 p.m. Wednesday, May 20, at Western Sierra Medical Clinic, 844 Old Tunnel Road in Grass Valley.

Wendy Van Wagner, community nutrition educator of Nutrition Education and Obesity Prevention for the Nevada County Health Department, will detail how to curb time and cut calories in the kitchen during the Weight Loss Support Group Class.

"I emphasize increasing consumption of fresh fruit and vegetables as well as whole grains and lean proteins," said Van Wagener, who has taught classes at Family Resource Centers, Hospitality House, Interfaith Food Ministry and many other groups in the region. "Our classes are both informative and hands-on, so participants can leave feeling empowered to create simple, healthy and tasty dishes that will help to improve their health.

Van Wagener's appearance is part of the ongoing Weight Loss Support Group Class at Western Sierra. The classes are 4 p.m. every Wednesday. Participants can attend, skip or start the classes at any time.

The weekly group provides emotional and education support for those wanting to lose weight. A psychologist and dietitian cover the emotional aspects of obesity and give practical tools for reducing weight during the ongoing classes.

"It's critical that participants learn how to make fast and healthy dishes, which is always a challenge for everyone, regardless of your weight," said Danielle Yantis, a nutritionist with Western Sierra and who oversees the Weight Loss Support Group Class. "But it's just as important, maybe even more so, to have the support of a group."
